Our Mission:

Our mission is to strive to create a loving, holistic and healthy environment for the children, women and people of Nepal whose lives we have been entrusted with. We aim to care for the desperately needy children, women and needy people of Nepal so as to create healthy, self-reliant citizens.



Objectives:

The main objectives of NCF delivered through these programmes are:

- Operate children's home for abandoned, poor & vulnerable children with necessary health care, education and vocational training.
- · Grant educational scholarships to capable but poor children.
- · Run skills development program to generate employment & to reduce poverty.
- · Promote entrepreneurship through micro business loans for poor families.
- · Provide clinical services to improve/restore hearing to the hearing impaired.
- · Provide unique opportunities for foriegners to work closely with Nepali culture

NCH's ultimate goal is to support as many poor, needy and abandoned children, women and needy people as possible.

Visma Raj Paudel's dream to help the poor, needy adults and orphaned children of Nepal came to fruition the day he was able to open the doors of NCF in June 2003. He strongly believes that together we can bring about great lasting impact to their lives. For Mr. Paudel, the opportunity to help others is very rewarding even though arranging the funds necessary is always a big challange. He has contributed 20 years in his life and is very glad to find that his dream is also the dragm of so many other people new

his dream is also the dream of so many other people now.



In our initial phase, we provided housing for around 60 orphan children in a rented building in Jarewar, Pokhara. It quickly became evident that there was much more to be addressed, such as educational scholarships for other needy children, women's empowerment programs, hearing aid distribution & treatment and sustainability programs and small business loans for poor families. All these programs are described in detail below, are up and running smoothly. This is greatly due to the efforts, generosity and time of others, like you.

Actress Angelina Jolie supported 20,000 USD to start our children's home at lakeside through a US charity. UK famous actress Joanna Lumley (OBE) also supported our project. She visited our home in July 2009 along with her husband, Stephen Barlow, and son, Jamie Lumley.



Over 106 children have been rescued from different circumstances & supported in our two rented homes called Namaste Children's House and Onni Children's House, located in Lakeside and Damside, Pokhara. Their ages vary from 4 years to 18 years, all arriving from various unfortunate backgrounds. All of our children are empowered and embraced by our loving and caring "family". They attend private schools to gain proper education necessary to lead a better life. Over 36 children have successfully reintegrated till date & are enrolled in differnt jobs throughout Pokhara and other parts of Nepal.



Our scholarship program provides over 169 children from poor families and single-parent households with supervised educational support in the form of school uniforms, educational materials, school bags, medical treatment, tuition fees, pocket money, and sets of extra clothes every year. Over 27 children have successfully completed 10th grade & are enrolled in higher secondary levels.



The Women Empowerment Centre building has been completed and is ready to start the lifelong skills from October 2013 to create financial independency for poor & needy women of Nepal. This project was designed to train at least 80-100 people in tailoring, crafts, agriculture, sustainable farming and other skills as per need. This effort will also help older children in the Namaste Family and poor single women of Nepal to gain important skills to secure employment.

Our volunteer placement program offers many unique opportunities to work within NCF & other social organizations. Over the past nine years, we have hosted over 500 volunteers from different parts of the world. 
